

Mumbai Metro Line 9 Nears Partial Launch, Boosting Realty Demand in Dahisar–Mira–Bhayandar Belt

Mumbai Metro Line 9, the long-anticipated metro corridor connecting Dahisar East to Mira-Bhayandar is on the verge of opening its first phase, bringing a landmark shift in connectivity and catalyzing real estate demand across the northern suburbs of the Mumbai Metropolitan Region. According to recent reports, the Commissioner of Metro Rail Safety (CMRS) has given the go-ahead for opening Phase 1 of Metro Line 9 — the 4.5-km Dahisar to Kashigaon stretch — and plans are afoot to throw it open in the last week of Jan or first week of Feb.

The Metro Line 9 project, essentially an extension of Metro Line 7 (Red Line), will provide the first rapid transit access to Mira-Bhayandar residents, linking them directly with the Western Express Highway and further into Andheri via existing metro corridors. Initial operations are expected between Dahisar East, Pandurang Wadi, Miragaon and Kashigaon, with subsequent phases extending the line deeper into Bhayandar.
